Camp LEAD is a week-long leadership camp that helps youth with disabilities develop self-advocacy and leadership, while providing job skills training and exposure to careers in natural resources.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- Young people ages 16-22
- Must be OR Vocational Rehabilitation clients (OVRs)
- Applicants should be able to complete light physical labor on uneven, unpaved terrain for approximately 6 hours a day (with some accommodation if necessary)

CAMP SCHEDULE

- Week 1: July 8-12 at LaPine State Park
- Week 2: July 15-19 at LaPine State Park
- Week 3: July 22-26 at LaPine State Park
- Week 4: Aug 5-9 at Silver Falls State Park
- Week 5: Aug 12-16 at Silver Falls State Park
- Week 6: Aug 19-23 at Silver Falls State Park
