 - Earn school credit through your school counselor
- Build your resume and explore post-high school opportunities
- Network with US Forest Service and natural resource specialists

- 2.5 additional weeks (after Camp LEAD) of outdoor conservation work across Central Oregon (building fences, trail maintenance, cleaning campgrounds, etc.)
 - Earn minimum wage
- Attend College Day and Career Day to learn more about post-secondary opportunities
 - August 7-24, Mondays through Thursdays (see back for calendar)
 - Between 7:00 am – 4:30 pm (exact pick-up and drop-off times TBD)

>>>>>>>>>The Process<<<<<<<<<<

1. Transition Specialists will send Heart of Oregon's Summer Program Coordinator an informal recommendation via email or phone about which campers would be the best match for the COYCC experience. At this time, please share any accommodations that the youth might need, especially interpretive or mobility services.
2. Transition Specialists will verify with the youth and parents/guardians that they will be available for this experience and make sure the youth and families "save the date." Please share this pre-confirmation with the Summer Program Coordinator.
3. Youth will attend Camp LEAD during their designated session.
4. Camp LEAD counselors will assess youth during their time at camp and provide a secondary recommendation if they are a good fit for COYCC.
5. After camp, the Summer Program Coordinator will contact the youth who have been selected, along with their Transition Specialists and parents to invite them to join the COYCC Integration experience. At this time, youth/families/Transition Specialists can discuss any necessary accommodations with the Summer Program Coordinator.
6. Youth will know if they have been selected no later than August 3rd and need to be ready to start work by Monday, August 7th.
